About half of the food the world produces is never eaten. It is instead thrown away. Experts say food is wasted in both rich and poor countries, but for different reasons. In poor countries, food is usually lost while it is still in the field or during storage and transportation. That is because food producers are inefficient. These businesses are unable to operate effectively without wasting materials, time or energy. But once food is sold in developing countries, people usually eat everything they buy. However, people in the developed countries throw away as much as half of the food they purchase.

To solve the problem, Elliot Woolley has created a smartphone app that shows users what food they have bought and when the food is about to become unsafe to eat. **It** also gives information on how people can combine the foods they have to make a meal. The software program is called the “Pantry App.” People who used the app reduced the amount of food they wasted by a third. But it could get people to waste more food because they no longer have to pay attention to how much they have bought. Other researchers say one way to solve the problem of wasted food is to take **steps** to persuade people to stop buying so much food in the first place. People buy more food than they need because it is becoming less costly and they waste so much food because they bought more than they needed.
