Regarding heart health, recent studies have shown a significant decrease in the risk of heart failure associated with moderate coffee consumption.

While coffee can be part of a healthy lifestyle, it is important to be careful of how it is consumed. Adding dairy, sugars, flavors, or nondairy creamers can introduce excess calories, sugar, and fat, negating the heart-healthy benefits of coffee. Despite its potential benefits, coffee can still make us feel excited and trembling due to the caffeine. Excessive caffeine intake can make it hard to fall asleep, even if consumed four hours before bedtime. However, these issues can be managed by limiting the coffee consumed. There is evidence of health benefits for adults who drink moderate amounts of coffee (3-4 cups daily, providing 300-400 mg of caffeine).
